In 2021, the Society for Environmental Economics and Policy Studies (SEEPS) launched a new event called the SEEPS Camp. Following the success of the SEEPS Camp 2021 and 2022, we are happy to announce that we will organize the **SEEPS Camp 2023** in February. The purpose of the Camp is to bring together a small group of outstanding Ph.D. students and young researchers who will lead the SEEPS in the future and to provide them with opportunities to interact with each other. The SEEPS Camp is expected to be a platform for young researchers who engage in environmental economics and policy studies to meet and encourage each other.

Ten participants will present their research plans or outcomes and exchange ideas. They will have an opportunity to join a panel session with mid-career members of the SEEPS who will share how to develop an academic career, and they will also have time to talk with the participants.

The Camp 2023 will be held **online**. The next year, we plan to organize the Camp in person for two days.

<u>Dates:</u> On the afternoons of February 16 and 17, 2023 (from 14:30 to 19:45 JST, including a social gathering)

Eligibility:

To apply for the SEEPS Camp 2023, you must hold a master's degree. The applicants would be a Ph.D. student, a businessperson who has received a master's degree within the past eight years, or an early career researcher who has received a Ph.D. within the past five years at the time of the application.

Non-members of SEEPS and those living outside Japan are also welcome.
