In 2021, the Society for Environmental Economics and Policy Studies (SEEPS) launched a new event called the SEEPS Camp. Following the success of the four SEEPS Camps, we are happy to announce to hold the in-person **SEEPS Camp 2024** in August. The purpose of the Camp is to bring together a small group of outstanding Ph.D. students and young researchers who will lead the SEEPS in the future and to provide them with opportunities to interact with each other. We further aim at building a network among them who aspire to be leading environmental economists

Participants will present their research plans or outcomes and exchange ideas. They will also join a special session and discuss with mid-career researchers of the SEEPS who will share their experiences of an academic career development. The camp will be held in the Nasushiobara area, Tochigi Prefecture.

Eligibility:

To apply for the SEEPS Camp 2024, you must hold a master's degree. The applicants would be a Ph.D. student, a business person who has received a master's degree within the past eight years, or an early career researcher who has received a Ph.D. within the past five years at the time of the application.

Non-members of SEEPS and those living outside Japan are also welcome, although the travel cost to Japan is not provided.

The application deadline is **June 21, 2024**. Eight participants at maximum will be selected. The result will be notified to you in the middle of July.
